The Mayor asked for input from the Council on continuing to get quotes or let Blount finish the work with the change order. Mr. Hill asked what needed to be done to the asphalt. It was explained by Mr. Powell that this was not just asphalt, it was 3 driveways, islands around lights and pouring curbs for parking. It would be more costly to spot fix.

Mr. Blount addressed the Council and briefed them on the process. He told the Council this price consisted to 3 commercial driveways, base, and demo. He explained that bad spots in concrete indicates something is wrong underneath and needs to be replaced.

Mr. McPhaul asked for clarification on the \$58,000 and the work being done in the change order.

Councilman Powell motioned to approve the change order and the additional \$50,000 to complete the parking lot and other line items, seconded by Mr. Jones.

Mayor Yearta pointed out that they were not just trying to spend money, they wanted the job done right and would inevitably save the taxpayers money. After discussion-*Motion Carries*
