SUBJECT: 2019-2020 ADOPTION OF FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

Mayor Yearta called the meeting to order and asked Mr. Rash to speak on the budget. He said the budget was \$20,158,117, with 3 adjustments made from the last meeting. The Mayor noted that we can always amend the budget. Mr. Rash cautioned the Council to watch spending. There was mention of the various capital improvement funds. PD will be paid out in about 2 years, which is a \$15,000 monthly payment. Medical claims are posing a strain on the budget, and alternatives really need to be explored.

Health insurance costs should be a priority for the City Manager. Employees may have to shoulder more of the burden of health costs.


There was discussion on the rates charged for cemetery plots. It was decided to discuss it at the Work Session

Mr. Jones moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Johnson – *Motion Carries*
