CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Pro Tem Charles Jones

SUBJECT: To Discuss the Approved Activities of the City's CDBG:

1. CDBG funds have been approved for Water Distribution System Improvements.
2. Project will benefit 355 persons of which 340 are low to moderate income residents.
3. Funds are available for the following activities:
 - a. Approximately \$705,400.00 for activity P-03J-01 Water facilities
 - b. Approximately \$45,000.00 for activity A-21A-00 Administration
4. Approximately \$529,181.00 from the city in local match and leverage. Total project cost is approximately \$1,279,181.00

Mayor Pro Tem Charles Jones opened the meeting and read the bulleted points above. He added that the city is very fortunate to receive these grants. Bob Roberson commented that DCA funded 55 projects and this was a top 5 project-congratulations documenting the need along with great pictures.

Mr. Powell questioned the change in the grant amount. Mr. Roberson informed the Council that DCA increased the grant amount to \$750,000, and now funds 55 projects instead of 68.

There were no comments from the Public regarding language barriers or disabilities.

The Mayor Pro Tem duly adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:52 PM. *Unanimous Consent*
