SUBJECT: To Elect a Mayor Pro Tem  
To Approve Resolution Establishing Qualifying Period for the Election of Councilman for the Unexpired Term of District 3 Councilman Charles Jones

The City Clerk called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Councilman Powell motioned to elect Councilman Larry Johnson as Mayor Pro Tem, and was seconded by Councilman Hill. ***3-0- Motion Carries***

Mayor Pro Tem brought forth the Resolution establishing the qualifying period for the election of Councilman for the unexpired term of District 3 Councilman.

Councilman Powell motioned to approve the Resolution and a second was offered by Councilman Hill – ***3-0 Motion Carries***

Mr. Powell said he was not aware of the personnel policy in reference to an employee on workman's comp not being able to receive benefits as other city employees.
