9) FEMA PAYMENTS AND UPDATE

Ms. Jinny Boyd submitted a FEMA Funds Report outlining the current status of funds in regards to closed out and received funds from FEMA. The documents presented showed projected costs and totals that the city received from FEMA. Two Tornadoes and one hurricane have been completed. Hurricane Michael is still being processed. Presently the total amount received from FEMA for all projects is \$471,699.80. There are approved projects left to be paid (See Exhibit A). Mr. Powell made a point to show that the City must have money on hand to sustain through a storm. Mr. Hayes noted that we are slightly under our goal to maintain the government without having to borrow. Jinny was thanked for her hard work in getting this work completed.

PRESENTATIONS: COUNCILMEN RANDY HILL AND MELVIN POWELL

With family and friends present Mayor Pro Tem Johnson presented Mr. Hill and Mr. Powell with plaques for their years of service. Mr. Powell was presented a plaque for 24 years of dedicated service to the City. Mr. Hill was presented a plaque for 15 years of dedicated service. They both spoke briefly highlighting their love and commitment to the City and thanked the public for allowing them to serve. They were commended for a job well done, and they will surely be missed.

10) RESOLUTION NO: 2019-26 – AMENDING CURRENT BUDGET

Mr. Rash, Finance Director, stated the current budget had to be amended by \$2,339,000 to be in compliance with state law. Mr. Rash submitted a budget amendment worksheet that showed increases and decreases for specific departments (See Exhibit B). Mr. Hayes elaborated on expenditures reported and noted that there should be improvement to the reserves going forward. Mr. Powell would like 400-500 thousand dollars to be budgeted each year to cover our need. Mr. Hayes shared revenue opportunities with the Council.
