Ms. Kelly is currently working on a joint application grant with the County for broadband. Mr. Hayes stated the pricing is reasonable and will be a good addition for the City.

## **Other Items:**

Mr. Hayes briefed the Council on the Henry Hall Woolard Center roof problem. Because of the urgency of the matter, he would like approval to proceed. Bids were received from Luke Billingsley Construction, S&S Roofing & Construction and Drawdy Construction, Inc. Based on how quickly the project can be started and completed, he suggests S&S Construction awarded the bid. Mr. Johnson expressed
