### **Non-Profit Temporary Food Service Events**

Governor Brian Kemp recently signed Senate Bill 345 amending Article 14, relating to non profit food sales and food service.

As amended in O.C.G.A. §26-2-391, a county or municipality is authorized to issue permits for the operation on nonprofit sales and food services at events sponsored by the county, municipality, or an organization.

Previously, the Worth County Environmental Health Office was responsible for the permitting process. Under the new law, temporary food service permits for non profit events will be issued by the City of Sylvester Community Development Department and inspections will still be performed by the Worth County Environmental Health Office.
